## **APPROVED ASSESSOR TRAINING**

#### Who is it for?

This course is for persons who are working in a front line capacity with persons who need aids/equipment to assist them in their daily living.

This one day course will give you the tools of competency in the ordering of daily living equipment.

We are working in partnership with Essex County Council who will issue the PIN and Login details upon completion of this course.

The course will cover the following:

- ✓ To provide Information, Guidance and Permission to access and order a specific range of equipment identified during the assessment or review process as necessary to meet identified, eligible needs.
- ✓ To ensure you are competent when assessing for equipment.
- ✓ To inform you of the process of ordering equipment via Essex County Council's Uniqus portal.

This course is certificated based on competency in the ordering of specific equipment and will include the issuing of Login & PIN details for delegates upon completion.

Please Note: This course is suitable for Health & Social Care staff who are wishing to provide social care equipment to those who have long term disabling impairments (with no significant recovery or improvement) using an ECC Uniqus PIN.

This course is NOT SUITABLE for health staff who would like a PIN to order Health Equipment. Any enquiries relating to this will need to be had with health management.

How long is it? One day – 09:00-17:00

### **FOOD HYGIENE - LEVEL 2**

#### Who is it for?

This one day course has been designed to help anyone who works within the catering industry handling, preparing or serving food.

By law, all food handlers much have an understanding of the basic principles of food hygiene and know how to work safely so as to protect the food they serve from contamination.

This course provides learners with up-to-date food hygiene information using a range of written and interactive exercises to ensure learners thoroughly comprehend their food safety responsibilities.

#### The course will cover:

- Understand how individuals can take personal responsibility for food safety in their environment
- ✓ To understand the importance of keeping him / herself clean and hygienic
- To understand the importance of keeping wok areas clean and hygienic

## PAEDIATRIC FIRST AID Level 2

#### Who is it for?

This one day course will cover the basics of first aid principles for persons working within an infant and child environment.

#### The course will cover:

- Be able to provide first aid for an infant and child who is unresponsive and breathing normally
- Be able to provide first aid for an infant and child who is unresponsive and not breathing normally
- Be able to provide first aid to an infant and child who:
  - ✓ Has a foreign body airway obstruction
  - ✓ External bleeding
  - ✓ Suffering from shock
  - ✓ With anaphylaxis symptoms

The course will include both practical demonstrations / assignment and oral examination with the practical being assessed by simulation. The course will be certified.

### MCA DoLS TRAIN THE TRAINER

#### MCA DoLS - TRAIN THE TRAINER

#### Who is it for?

Working knowledge of both the MCA & DoLS legislation is of paramount importance to upholding the good standards of care expected from those in the care sectors.
